# WHAT TO BRING AND WHAT NOT TO BRING TO CRAIG SPRINGS CAMPS

### WHAT TO BRING:

- Toiletries: (soap/toothbrush/toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, etc.)
- Clothing: Shorts and Pants. T-shirts, Jacket/Sweaters/Sweatshirts. Swimwear, Underwear, and socks. Leave the following at home --Shirts and clothing that display messages or illustrations of a profane or suggestive nature or relate to drugs, alcohol, or any illegal substance are prohibited from being worn. You may not wear Low-cut shirts. Clothing that shows boxers, underwear or bras. Shorts that show your bottom when you bend over are a no. Swimsuits that you wouldn't wear in front of someone you respect can be left
- Shoes: Shoes must be worn at all times. Closed-toe shoes are required on hikes and at night. Sandals/flip flops/open toed shoes are allowed when not on hikes. Make sure you wear shoes that you can walk in. You will do some walking.
- Rain Wear: for those sudden downpours
- The Important Stuff: Insect Repellent, Sunscreen, Flashlight, Bible, Pencils/Pens Paper, Stamps and envelopes to write the folks back home.
- Sleeping Gear: Sleeping Bag, Sheets/ Blanket Pillow & Pillowcase Towel for showers and the pool & Washcloths. Fan and power strip/extension cord to stay cool at night.

### DO NOT BRING:

- Laptops, Sound systems or TVS
- **Fireworks**
- Candles, incense or anything else that creates an open flame
- Shaving cream (unless you are of shaving age)
- Weapons of any kind—including knives
- Tobacco or Electronic Cigarettes

You may bring music players with headphones for rest & sleep times.

Each camp shall establish a cell phone/electronic device policy for the respective camp.

Craig Springs is not responsible for lost or stolen valuables

## **IMPORTANT NOTE:**

The presence and use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will result in the camper being sent home. The use of all tobacco, vape products is banned.

In the interest of putting your child's safety and security first, Craig Springs management reserves the right to search camper's and staff member's personal belongings and/or vehicle if there is reason to suspect illegal substances or weapons. If a search is conducted there will always be two adults present, and the camper/staff member being searched will be given the option to be present. All efforts to protect their privacy will be made.

Prescription Medications: The camp nurse will keep all prescription medications. They MUST be sent to camp in the original containers so the camp nurse can verify dosage. DO NOT send prescription medications in plastic bags, pill boxes or any other container.
